DRESS CODE

All camp participants (campers, faculty, staff) MUST dress modestly and decently so that their attire does not disrupt the camp experience.

The Camp Manager is the final authority in matters of dress.

1) Shirts, shoes, and pants/shorts must be worn at all times unless swimming.

2) Clothes that are too revealing are not allowed. Below are a few examples:

- No spaghetti strap
- Undergarments, such as boxers or bras/straps, should not be visible.
- Shirts that are tied, ripped, or cut must not show skin or undergarments.
- Shirts, when arms are lifted, cannot show more than 2 inches of midriff.
- Open-backed shirts, such as tube tops or halter tops, are not allowed.
- Shorts need to be an appropriate length

3) Clothes should not display inappropriate graphics or messages.

4) Swimsuit Policy:

- All individuals must wear shorts (swim shorts are acceptable) and a shirt when traveling to and from the lake and other water activities.
- All individuals must wear a lifejacket when swimming or participating in other lake activities.
- Swimsuits should not be low cut, show the midriff, or be too revealing.
- If wearing a two piece (excluding modest tankinis), it must be covered with a dark colored t-shirt.
